1: ADMISSION



Interview Room: You will be asked questions by the Doctors and Nurses.

2: WAITING ROOM



3: DAY SURGERY UNIT (DSU)



Where you change into theatre attire and dressing gown.



8: RECOVERY ROOM



The Recovery nurse will give you medicine as required.



7: OPERATING ROOM



9: HOME OR WARD

Your Doctor would have discussed with you your discharge plan.

If going home, you will be transferred to DSU for approximately 1-4 hours.

If staying overnight, you will be transferred to a ward.



4: THEATRE HANDOVER BAY



On arrival to theatre you will be assisted onto a trolley.

You will be asked questions about yourself, your procedure and your name bands will be checked.

If you have any questions, please ask the nurse.



6: ANAESTHETIC ROOM

The Anaesthetic Assistant will introduce you to the Theatre Staff and clarify: allergies, consent and operation name.

The Anaesthetist will prepare you for your operation.

5: TRANSFER TO SURGERY



The Anaesthetic Assistant will transport you to the theatre.
